



The health, well being and safety of our staff and customers is at the top of our priority list at all times. During a time of uncertainty like we are currently faced with, we want all to understand that we are taking extra precautionary measures at our brew pub to help minimize any anxieties for both staff and customers. A sense of normalcy is all something we are looking for. As we start to turn the corner on this global situation we want everyone to understand that we will continue to keep safety, sanitation and awareness at the top of our priority list. Per Governor Cuomo, will be opening our outdoor dining area for service starting Friday (6-5-2020) at 11:30 am. We ask that any patron that chooses to join us does so with patience and compassion for our staff and fellow patrons. The Adirondack Brewery will be taking the following steps here at the brew pub to help with the risk of contracting or spreading of this virus. These steps include but are not limited to the following:

- Face covering will be **REQUIRED** for all **staff** and **customers** on the property. Customers must wear a face covering at all times when not eating
- We have switched to paper menus for easy disposal and less cross contamination.
- We have removed all table top material that could aid with the transfer of this virus from person to person.
- We are moving towards single use ketchup packets and single use Salty and Pepper. (Just ask your server if you need more than what is provided )
- We have installed hand sanitizer dispensers throughout the restaurant and entire building. As well as bottles on each table.
- We will have a dedicated person doing diligent cleaning and sanitizing during open business hours of all accessible flat surfaces and high risk contact points such as door knobs, POS stations, etc. This will be this person's only and main focus.
- We have removed tables and chairs from our dining areas to help address some of the density concerns and to ensure social distancing.
- We will continue to clean and use a Food Grade sanitizer on all tables in between seating's.
- We will not be able to allow any groups **larger than 10** to be seated together.
- In the case we are on a wait. We will be asking customer to **wait in their cars** until they are informed their table is ready.
- The inside of the restaurant will remain **CLOSED**. Other than for the use of restrooms.
- Entrances and exits will be visibly marked as well as marking on the floors and ground to help with traffic flow.
- We will be implementing health screenings for our employees
- We will still encourage online ordering and takeout as well as dining on site.

Any employee that may feel sick in any way has been asked to **STAY HOME**. We ask the same from our customer. Please stay healthy, best wishes and Thanks You for your continued support over these past 3 months. It has been very difficult to not see you all. And we look forward to serving you here at the brewery.
